

Signs and symptoms of Graves' Disease may be due to hyperthyroidism and/or eye disease:

***Hyperthyroidism Symptoms:***

Heat intolerance and excessive sweating  
Palpitation  
Tremors  
Increased frequency of bowel movements

***Symptoms of Thyroid Eye Disease:***

Eye swelling, enlargement, prominence  
Pain when moving the eyes  
Swelling around the eyes and double vision  
In severe cases, vision loss may occur

***Factors that can increase your risk of developing Graves' disease include:***

Women (especially during childbearing ages)  
Individuals with a family history of thyroid disease  
People with other autoimmune diseases
